

STARLINK GROUP 6-22 MISSION



MISSION OVERVIEW

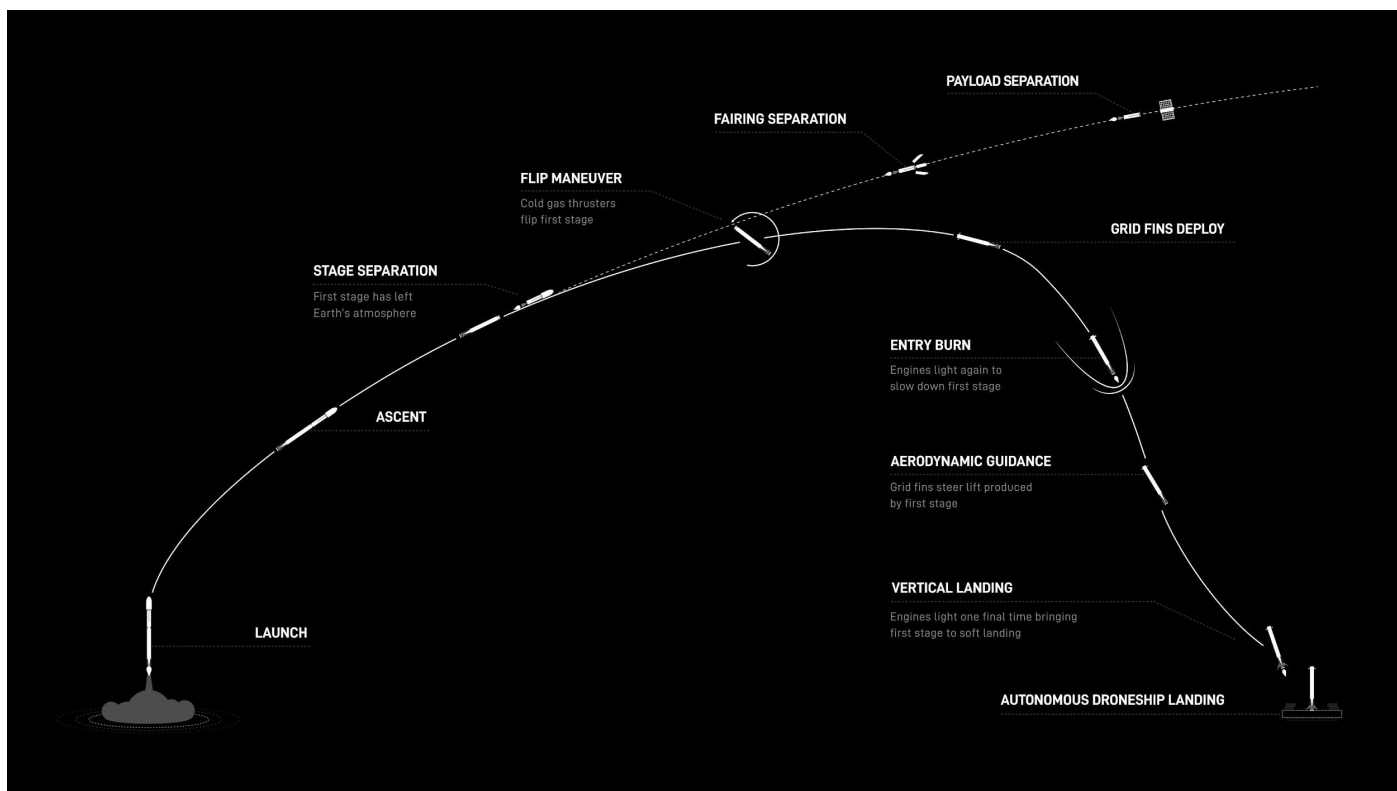
SpaceX is targeting Sunday, October 8 at 9:06 p.m. ET for a Falcon 9 launch of 22 **Starlink** satellites to low-Earth orbit from Space Launch Complex 40 (SLC-40) at Cape Canaveral Space Force Station in Florida. If needed, four backup opportunities are available starting at 9:57 p.m. ET until 12:29 a.m. ET on Monday, October 9. Five backup opportunities are also currently available on Monday, October 9 starting at 8:41 p.m. ET until 12:03 a.m. ET on Tuesday, October 10.

This is the 14th flight for the first stage booster supporting this mission, which previously launched CRS-22, Crew-3, Turksat 5B, Crew-4, CRS-25, Eutelsat HOTBIRD 13G, mPOWER-a, PSN SATRIA, and five Starlink missions. Following stage separation, the first stage will land on the A Shortfall of Gravitas droneship, which will be stationed in the Atlantic Ocean.
