# STARLINK MISSION

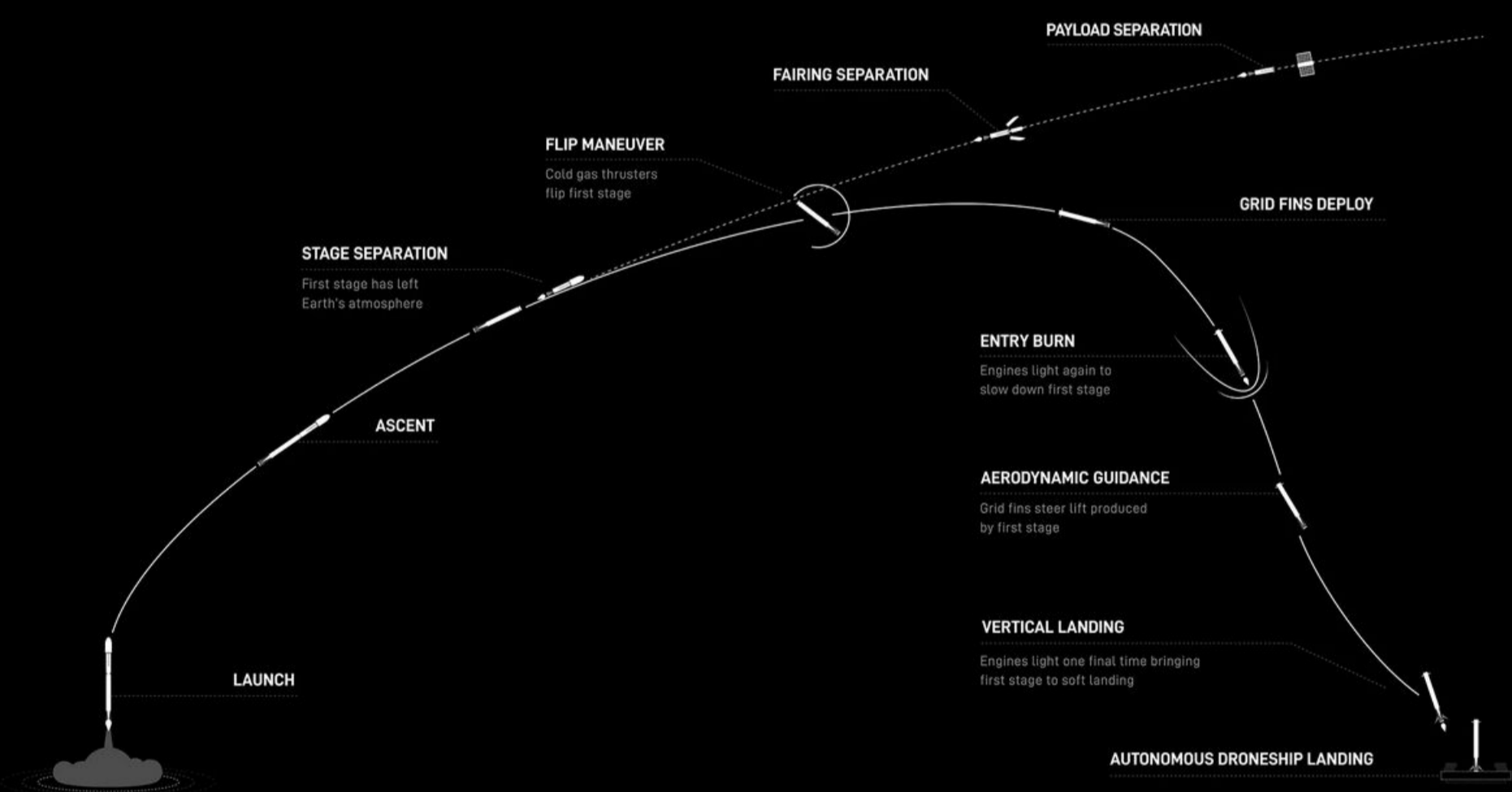
SpaceX is targeting Tuesday, February 6 for a Falcon 9 launch of 22 Starlink satellites to low-Earth orbit from Space Launch Complex 4 East (SLC-4E) at Vandenberg Space Force Base in California. Liftoff is targeted for 9:37 p.m. PT. If needed, additional opportunities are available on Wednesday, February 7 starting at 5:17 p.m. PT.

A live webcast of this mission will begin on X @SpaceX about five minutes prior to liftoff. **Watch live.**

This is the 14th flight for the first stage booster supporting this mission, which previously launched NROL-87, NROL-85, SARah-1, SWOT, Transporter-8, Transporter-9, and seven Starlink missions. Following stage separation, the first stage will land on the Of Course I Still Love You dronship, which will be stationed in the Pacific Ocean.
